

What You Should Know About DARFUR Right Now!

On 4 March 2009, the Government of Sudan announced the expulsion of 16 nongovernmental organizations (NGOs). The UN in Sudan reports the following:

• 1.5 million people will no longer have access to health and nutrition services.

- Water supply, sanitation and hygiene to 1.16 million people will be interrupted.
- 1.1 million people will stop receiving general food distribution.
- Nearly 7,000 children receiving treatment for severe and moderate malnutrition will be interrupted.
- Emergency shelter will immediately cease in 19 camps and locations in Darfur.
- A total of 4.7 civilians are dependent on aid to survive. If the trend continues, they are all in grave, and immediate danger.
